OFFICIAL STATUS NOTIFICATION (PR-1) FORM

The Act of June 8, 1938, as amended, mentioned in Item 1(b) of the Instructions printed on the attached form (PR-1) has recently been amended. (Public Law 532, 77th Cong., 2d Sess.)

The Act and the Regulations prescribed thereunder by the Attorney General provide that every person who is an agent of a foreign principal, as defined in Section 1 of the Act, shall file with the Attorney General a registration statement, unless specifically exempt by Section 3 of the Act. The exemptions provided in Section 3 include those available to duly accredited diplomatic and consular officers, to officials of foreign governments, and to members of the staff of, or any person employed by, duly accredited diplomatic or consular officers of foreign governments. Officials and employees of foreign governments who are engaged as public-relations counsel, publicity agents, or information-service employees are not exempt.

The filing of a Foreign Official Status Notification (Form FR-1) is not considered as compliance with the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, unless submitted as a claim of exemption under Section 3(a), (b) or (c) of the Act.

Under Item 15 of the Foreign Official Status Notification (Form (PR-1), specific mention should be made of all speaking activities, writing or editing of material for publication, and all activities connected with the dissemination of printed matter in which the signer expects or proposes to engage while in the United States.

On and after June 28, 1942, Form PR-1, as amended by this present supplement, should be filed in triplicate rather than in duplicate as in the past.
